



Athlete Information

1. **IWWF Event Management System (EMS):** It is now compulsory for any athlete who wishes to represent their country at IWWF events to register on the new IWWF Event Management System (EMS).

If you are interested in representing Singapore at any IWWF event, please contact and provide the [SWWF](#) with your personal particulars so that you can be registered as an athlete. Information required is as follows:

- Gender
- Date of Birth
- Country of Origin

IWWF Asian Championships Eligibility Rule

Non-citizens of countries may participate provided:

- a) the competitor is a resident of the country he is representing.
 - b) he has been resident for a minimum of 36 months prior to the competition or special dispensation may be granted by a panel comprising the IWWF Asia President, the IWWF Asia Secretary General and the Chairman of the IWWF Asia Waterski Council (AWC), Chairman of the IWWF Asia Wakeboard Council (AWBC) or Chairman of the IWWF Asia Wakesurf Council (AWSC)
 - c) he has not previously skied for another country for at least 12 months prior to taking up residency.
2. **[IWWF Licence](#)**
ALL Athletes participating in a waterski Ranking List competition (and not only the Athletes who want to have their names listed on the Ranking List!) must [purchase an IWWF Licence](#). This is not a Licence for those who want to be on the Ranking List but a Licence for those who want to PARTICIPATE in a Ranking List competition.
